DDEA Early-Career Researcher Award

Two awards of 25,000 DKK each presented to two individual early-career researchers from Danish research institutions who each has shown promising research and great potential to be world-class researchers within their fields of expertise and who each has made an important contribution to the understanding and treatment of diabetes and classical endocrine diseases. The two awards will be presented within 1) diabetes and 2) classical endocrinology.

DDEA Research Education and Networking Award

One award of 25,000 DKK presented to a national or international researcher at any point in their career who has been engaged in diabetes and/or classical endocrine research education in DDEA and/or the Danish Diabetes Academy and has shown substantial academic citizenship by raising the knowledge and competences of early-career researchers within DDEA/DDA.
